Have mercy upon us, Lord.*

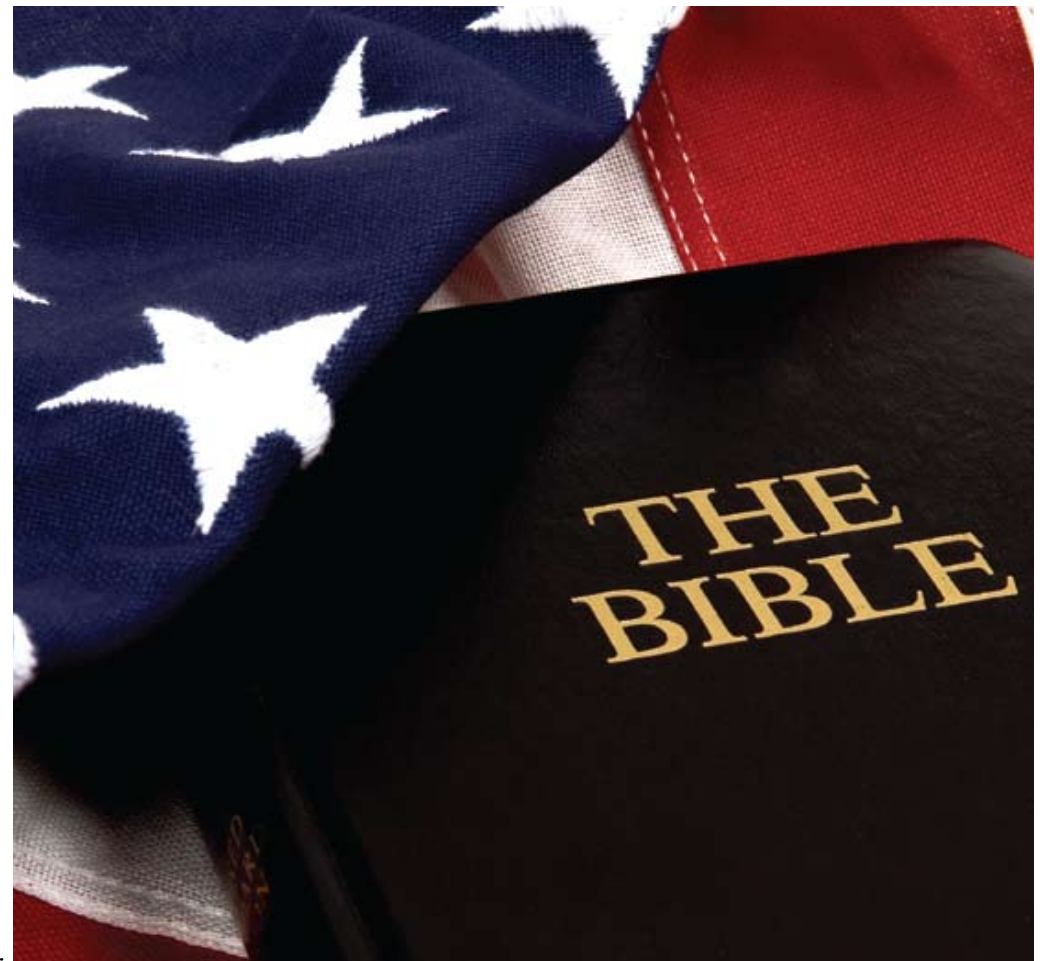
*Our nation is at a crossroads this year;

Abortion to Rise under Obama's Freedom of Choice Act

With the country now in the hands of Barack Obama, restrictions on abortion may soon vanish altogether. During his campaign, Obama vowed to pass the Freedom of Choice Act upon entering the oval office. If passed, this reckless and dangerous piece of legislation would have a devastating effect on America – increasing the number of abortions by more than 125,000 each year.

Under the Freedom of Choice Act, state laws that prevent a significant number of abortions annually would be nullified – including parental involvement requirements for minors (in place in 36 states), informed consent (26 states) and prohibition of government funding for abortion (34 states). Research studies conducted by Dr. Michael New, published by the Heritage Foundation, have proven these laws are responsible for a considerable reduction in abortion rates every year, and, without them, national numbers would skyrocket.

Here is a snapshot of what life would be like under the Freedom of Choice Act: underage girls throughout the United States could get abortions without

notifying their parents; mentally disabled or impaired individuals would be granted abortions more readily; women would have the right to abort a fully developed child in the final weeks of pregnancy for vague and nondescript reasons. And that's just the beginning - no one knows exactly how far this legislation could go in deregulating abortion.

Perhaps even worse than the illicit government endorsement of abortion implied by the Freedom of Choice Act is the fact that you, the taxpayer, would be forced to foot the bill for abortions through state and federal taxes. With an average 1.3 million abortions performed in the U.S. each year, do we really want to add another 125,000 – let alone, pay for them with our hard-earned money?

The National Committee for Faith and Family (NCF) is passionately opposed to the Freedom of Choice Act, and, with your support, we'll continue fighting this unlawful and immoral proposition.
